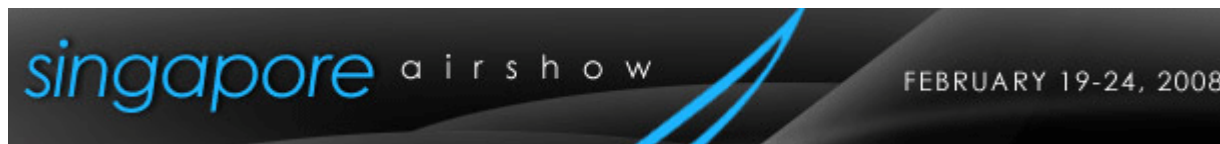

## Singapore Airshow Essential Facts

Singapore Airshow 2008 is organized by Singapore Airshow & Events Pte Ltd, a joint venture between Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore (CAAS) and Defense Science & Technology Agency (DSTA).

CAAS is a statutory board under the Ministry of Transport. It represents the government in the negotiation of air services agreements as well as advises on matters related to civil aviation. It also regulates and promotes the development of air transport.

DSTA is a statutory board set up under the Ministry of Defense (MINDEF). It is responsible for implementing defense technology plans, managing defense research and development, acquiring defense material and developing defense infrastructure for MINDEF.

### The New Changi Exhibition Center

This is the first air show in Singapore to take place at the newly built Changi Exhibition Centre (CEC). The site is located on the waterfront and includes a 40,000-square-meter, air-conditioned exhibition hall, a 100,000-square-meter outdoor display area, and a 2,000-lot car park. There is also an open area facing the sea for visitors to picnic while attending exhibitions or watching aerial displays.

The CEC is located 25 minutes from the Central Business District and 10 minutes from Singapore's Changi Airport.
